

Overview itinerary



Antofagasta:

The Antofagasta region is the most important mining region in the country. Around 50% of national production can be attributed to this area. Some of the country's most important copper mines and lithium processing plants are located near the city of Antofagasta.

Arrival day and onward journey to the Atacama Desert

Individual journey to Santiago de Chile

There are no direct flights to Santiago from Germany, good connections are:

- ✓ with Latam or Iberia via Madrid
- ✓ with AirFrance or KLM via Paris or Amsterdam
- ✓ with Latam or Lufhansa via Sao Paulo, Brazil.

Arrival at Arturo Merino Benitez airport, onward flight in the early afternoon to Calama.

The group meets at Hotel xxx for the first meeting. The participants receive a brief insight into the Chilean market and initial information on the topics of mining and mineral resources from the AHK. This will be followed by dinner together in Calama.

Visit Open Pit Copper Mine & AMA Project:

The day starts with a tour of the **world's largest open-pit copper mine: Chuquicamata**. Located in the Atacama Desert, the mine has been a major contributor to Chile's copper industry for over a century and offers insights into large-scale mining operations.

From Calama, the journey continues towards San Pedro de Atacama. Near the town we will visit SQM's AMA Women Project. The initiative supports local women through training, employment opportunities, and sustainable development projects in the Atacama region.

In the evening there will be a group dinner in San Pedro and an optional star gazing tour.

Site Visit Lithium extraction & Copper Mine:

From San Pedro, drive to the Salar de Atacama.

Visit to SQM's lithium extraction in the Salar de Atacama. SQM is the first company in the Chilean mining industry to receive certification in accordance with the 'Chilean Standard 3262 on Gender Equality Management and Work-Life Balance' for all its production sites.

Later on, we will continue to Codelco's Copper Mine "Gabriela Mistral". 8 % of the employees are from local indigenous communities.

In the evening there will be a dinner & Cocktails in Antofagasta, organized by ProChile Antofagasta and representatives of E+Mineras.

Site Visit Antofagasta and Flight to Santiago:

The day starts with a tour to the port of Antofagasta (or Mejillones). Afterwards, we will share a lunch and participate in a seminar by W4M, ProChile and WIM Chile.

In the evening, the participants will make their way to the airport in Calama, from where they will fly to Santiago.

Site Visit Santiago & Networking:

The participants are picked up at the delegation hotel and travel to Catemu to Anglo American's Chagres smelter. Chagres is located in the Valparaíso region, in the municipality of Catemu, 100 kilometres north of Santiago. It produces around 104,800 tonnes of fine copper per year. Chagres is currently recognised as one of the leading national smelters due to its high operational and environmental performance.

In the afternoon, we will drive back to Santiago to participate in a seminar organized by Women in Mining Chile.

The day will end with a shared Farewell Dinner & Cocktails.


